As You Prepare – All Saints' Day B

Isaiah 25:6-9: In accounts of the Last Supper, Jesus says that he will not drink wine again “until that day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God” (see Mark [14:25](#)). Earthly language is inadequate for expressing heavenly notions. Chapters [24](#) to [27](#) of Isaiah are a prophecy about the end-times; our reading is a description of the celestial banquet to which Jesus refers.

Revelation 21:1-6a: This is a prophecy which reveals secrets of heaven and earth. Our reading is from John’s record of his vision of the end-times.

John 11:32-44 Lazarus, Mary’s brother, has died. Martha has told Jesus that he would not have died had Jesus been present, but that the Father will grant whatever Jesus asks. Jesus has said to her: “Your brother will rise again, (v. [23](#)), which she takes to refer to the general resurrection Jews expected at the end of time. Jesus has answered: “I am the resurrection and the life”

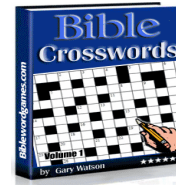
“From the Pantry”
