As you prepare for worship... Proper 5C

Isaiah 6:1-8: In this reading Isaiah has a vision of God enthroned, surrounded by courtiers, with seraphs, hovering above Him, guarding Him. One pair of wings covered their faces in the awesome presence of God, a second covered their feet, and the third is used to fulfil commissions from God. Isaiah wrote that he felt totally inadequate in God's presence: he felt unclean, unfit to stand before God, yet God graciously permitted it. An agent of God purified him, rendering him fit and qualified to speak God's word to His people. God conferred with His advisors asking whom He should send. Isaiah volunteered to be God's prophet.

1 Corinthians 15:1-11: Paul heard that there are those in Corinth who believed that only the spirit mattered, not the body. He then recited his own personal Creed: that Christ died a bodily death and was raised a bodily resurrection, having appeared to various apostles and members of the Church. Last of all, Paul wrote that the risen Christ even appeared to him, though he was a monster in persecuting the Church. All of this is because of God's grace.

Luke 5:1-11: The Lake of Genneserat is the Sea of Galilee. Jesus commandeered Peter's boat to continue preaching the Word to those on the seashore. Then he told Peter to sail out into the sea and lower his nets. After a night of catching nothing Peter took Jesus at his word (always a good idea!) and lowered them. They caught so much fish their nets began to break! Note how Peter's address of Jesus changed: from "Master" (Teacher) to an act of faith, "Lord." Like Isaiah, he expressed his unworthiness of being in Jesus' presence. Jesus responded gracefully: calling Peter to follow him, which he, James and John did.
