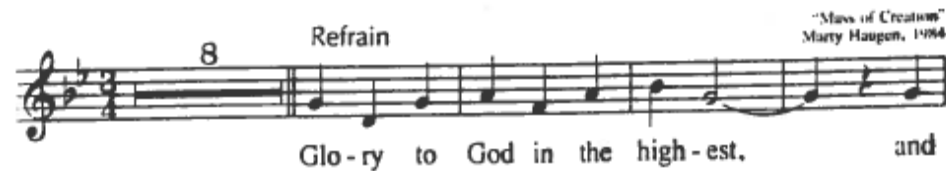


GLORIA

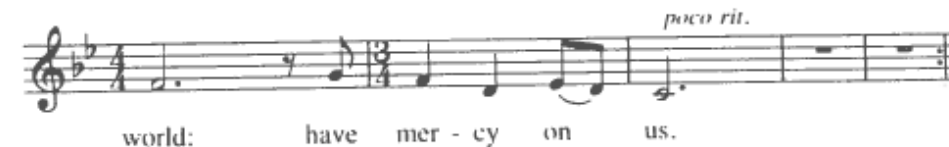

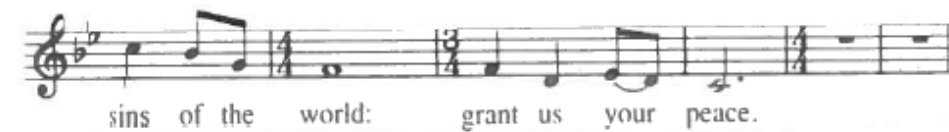
